- A Barna.com survey shows:
 - In 1993:
 - 89% of people agreed that it was every Christians responsibility to share their faith.
 - Only 10% of people said that it was the responsibility of the local congregation to people of Christianity.
 - In 2018:
 - A mere 64% of people agreed that it was every Christians responsibility to share their faith.
 - 47% of people said that it was the responsibility of the local congregation to people of Christianity.
