### What does it mean to be a denomination?

- It's not a biblical term.
- Definition of Denomination:
  - an act of denominating the denomination of prices in U.S. dollars
  - a value or size of a series of values or sizes metric denominations;
  - name, designation;
  - a religious organization whose congregations are united in their adherence to its beliefs and practices people from several different Christian denominations

#### Characteristics of a Denominational Church:

- 1. Denomination have a founder, other than Jesus.
- 2. Denomination have an earthly head (conference or board).
- 3. Denomination have a creed that has been established by its conference or board.
- 4. Denomination have the name of its founder or practice.
- 5. Denomination have an elaborate hierarchy (organization).
- 6. Denomination have traditional creed of worship.
- 7. Denomination have a list of mandatory requirements for membership into the organization.
