3 MISTAKEN IDEAS ABOUT BAPTISM

- It's just enough to be baptized.
- We should be baptizing individuals in the name of Jesus Christ only.
- It's not really necessary to understand the purpose of baptism.

IS IT JUST ENOUGH TO BE BAPTIZED?

- There are other things that God requires of us to be saved:
 - Faith (Hebrews 11:6)
 - Belief (Mark 16:15 16)
 - Obedience (John 14:15; John 15:14)
 - Repentance (Acts 2:37 38; Acts 17:30 31)
 - Confession (Matthew 10:32 33)
 - Love of the brethren (John 13:34 35)

- Is it baptism that saves us?
 - Of course not.
 - It's Christ's blood that washes away sins and saves us.
 - However, to obey the Gospel by being baptized is to follow Jesus Christ's command and it is in obeying the Gospel that we contact the Jesus Christ.
 - Acts 22:16
