## THE GREAT COMMISSION







What is able to save your soul? Engrafted word

1 Peter 1:23

Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

How is one born again? Word of God

Should you go to any other source to learn how to be saved?

#### 2 Timothy 3:16-17

All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

Does the Bible thoroughly furnish us unto every good work? Yes

Do we need additional revelations to make us complete before God?

Do we need the Book of Mormon to make us complete spiritually? No

Do we need Church Traditions, Manuals, Creed Books, Confession of Faith to make us complete spiritually? <u>No</u> 4-5.

2 Peter 1:3

According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue.

Has God given us all things that pertain to life and godliness? Yes

Since God has given us all things that pertain to life and godliness in the Bible, should any other source be used as our religious authority? No

#### **Deuteronomy 4:2**

Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the Lord your God which I command you.

Would you please God if we added to, or deleted anything from his word? <u>No</u>

#### Galatians 1:6-9

...But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed...

Will we be accursed if we add to, or take away from the Bible? Yes 5.

Leviticus 10:1-2

And Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, took either of them his censer, and put fire therein, and put incense thereon, and offered strange fire before the Lord, which he commanded them not

These men offered strange fire before the Lord, which he Commanded them not

Did they alter God's Commandments? Yes

Was God pleased with them? No

Must we be careful how we handle the word of God? Yes

#### 2 John 9

Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God, He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son.

If we do not abide in the doctrine of Christ, is God pleased? No

Do you want to please God? Yes

Matthew 15:9

But in vain they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.

Their worship to God was unacceptable because they taught for doctrines the commandments of men

#### Matthew 7:21

Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

Who will be allowed to enter heaven? <u>He who doeth the Father's Will</u>

Do you want to go to heaven? Yes

Hebrews 1:1-2

God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophet. Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom also he made the worlds.

God formerly gave his revelations to the fathers by the <u>Prophets</u> but today he speaks to us through <u>His Son</u>

**Matthew 28:18** 

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

How much authority did God give Jesus? All

#### John 12:48

He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last days.

We will be judged by the words of Jesus

John 1:17

For the law was given by Moses but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ

The law was given by Moses

Grace and truth came by \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus

Hebrews 9:15-17

And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgression that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

Is Jesus the mediator of the New Testament? Yes

When did the New Testament of Jesus go into effect? <u>At death</u>

#### **Hebrews 8:6-7**

But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises. For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second.

- Is Jesus the mediator of a better covenant? Yes
- If that first covenant (the Old Testament) had been faultless, would God have given us the second covenant (the New Testament)? <u>No</u>

Vs. 8 For finding fault with them he saith...

#### Hebrews 8:13

In that he saith, A new covenant, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old is ready to vanish away.

When God gave the New covenant, did he make the first one OLD (no longer in force)? Yes

#### Acts 13:38-39

Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins: And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.

Can we be justified by the law of Moses? No

#### Galatians 3:11-13

... And the law is not of faith: but, The man that doeth them shall live in them. Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree.

Is the law of faith? No

Did Christ redeem us from the curse of the law? Yes

### **Colossians 2:14**

Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross.

When was the bond written in ordinances abolished? When Jesus was nailed to the cross

#### **Ephesians 2:15**

Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace

What did Jesus abolish in his flesh? The law of commandments

#### Galatians 3:23-25

But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed. Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith. But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster.

Now that faith has come, are we under the law? No

#### Romans 7:4

Wherefore, my brethren, ye also are become dead to the law by the body of Christ; that ye should be married to another, even to him who is raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto God.

Paul says, "ye also are become dead to the law by the body of Christ."

Romans 7:6 But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not in the oldness of the letter.

Paul says, "now we are delivered from the law."

Is the New Testament the law spiritually binding today? Yes
