

### **Genesis 22:6-8**

### HOW COULD GOD ASK ABRAHAM TO SACRIFICE HIS SON, ISAAC?


- Deuteronomy 12:31

#### Hebrews 11:17-19 (NASB)

- <sup>17</sup> By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises was offering up his only begotten son;
- 18 it was he to whom it was said, "IN ISAAC YOUR DESCENDANTS SHALL BE CALLED."
- He considered that God is able to raise people even from the dead, from which he also received him back as a type.
