- As Jesus is being taken through the streets
- of Jerusalem to his crucifixion; he
- prophecies of the things he has already
- shared with his disciples and things
- prophesied by Isaiah, Danial, and
- numerous others.

- "But Jesus turning unto them said, Daughters of Jerusalem, weep not for me, but weep for yourselves, and for your children.
- For, behold, <u>the days are coming</u>, in the which they shall say, Blessed are the barren, and the wombs that never bare, and the paps which never gave suck.
- Then shall they begin to say to the mountains, Fall on us, and to the hills, Cover us.
- For if they do these things in a green tree, what shall be done in the dry?" Lk.23:28-31

Matt. 21:33-41 "Hear another parable: There was a certain householder, which planted a vineyard, and hedged it round about, and dug a winepress in it, and built a tower, and let it out to husbandmen, and went into a far country: vs 34 And when the time of the fruit drew near, he sent his servants to the husbandmen, that they might receive the fruits of it."

- Matt.25:35 "And the husbandmen took his
- servants, and beat one, and killed
- another, and stoned another.
- vs 36 Again, he sent other servants
- more than the first: and they did unto
- them likewise. vs37 But last of all he
- sent unto them his son, saying,
 - They will reverence my son. vs38 But
 - when the husbandmen saw the son,
 - they said among themselves,

- this is the heir; come, let us kill him, and
- let us seize on his inheritance. vs39 And they
- caught him, and cast him out of the vineyard
- and slew him. Vs40 When the lord therefore
- of the vineyard comes, what will he do unto
- those husbandmen? Vs41 They say unto him,
- "He will miserably destroy those wicked
- men, and will let out his vineyard unto other
- husbandmen, which shall render him the
- fruits in their season."

Matt. 23:29-38 "Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! Because you build the tombs of the prophets, and garnish the sepulcheres of the righteous. vs30 And say, If we had been in the days of our fathers, we would not have been partakers with them in the blood of the prophets.

Matt. 23:31 "Wherefore you be witnesses unto yourselves, that you are the children of them which killed the prophets. vs32 Fill you up the measure of your fathers. vs33 You serpents, you generation of vipers, how can you escape the damnation of hell? vs34 Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: and some of them you shall kill and crucify; and some of them shall you

- scourge in your synagogues, and persecute
- them from city to city; vs35 That upon you
 - may come all the righteous blood shed upon
 - the earth, from the blood of righteous Able
 - unto the blood of Zacharias son of Barachias,
 - whom you shew between the temple and the
 - alter. vs36 Verily I say unto you, All these
 - things shall come upon this generation.

Matt. 10:5-42 note vs 23

- vs37 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that
- killed the prophets, and stoned them
- which are sent unto you, how often
- would I have gathered your children
- together, even as a hen gathers her
- chickens under her wings, and you
- WOULD NOT!
- vs38 Behold, your house is left unto you
- desolate.

- Rm. 10:20-21 "But Isaiah is very bold, and
- said, "I was found of them that
- sought me not; I was made manifest
- unto them that asked not after me.
- vs21 But to Israel he said, All day
- long I have stretched forth my hands
- unto a disobedient and gainsaying
- people."
- Paul quoting from Isaiah 65:2-3a

- Isa. 65:2-3a "I have spread out my hands
- unto a rebellious people, which
- walk in a way that was not good,
- after their own thoughts;
- vs3a A people that provoked me to anger
- continually to my face...."

Isa. 62:1-3 "For Zion's sake will I not hold my peace, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, until the righteousness thereof go forth as brightness, and the salvation thereof as a lamp that burns. Vs2 And the Gentiles shall see your righteousness, and all kings your glory; and you shall be called by a new name, which the mouth of the Lord shall name."

Isa. 61:1-2 "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the Lord has anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and the opening of the prison to them that

are bound;

- vs2 "To proclaim the acceptable year of the
- Lord, and the day of vengeance of
- our God; to comfort all that mourn;"
- Isa. 63:4 "For the day of vengeance is in
- mine heart, and the year of my
- redeemed is come."
- Isa. 34:8 "For it is the day of the Lord's
- vengeance, and the year of
- recompences for the controversy
- of Zion."

- Matt. 24:1-2 "And Jesus went out, and
- departed from the temple; and his
- disciples came to him for to show
- him the buildings of the temple.
- vs2 And Jesus said unto them, See
- you not all these things: verily I say
- unto you, There shall not be left here
- one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down."

- Matt. 24:3Tell us, when shall these things
- be? and What shall be the sign of your
- coming, and the end of the age?
- Matt. 24:15 "When you therefore shall see
- the abomination of desolation, spoken
- of by Daniel, the prophet...."
- Luke 21:20 "And when you shall see
- Jerusalem compassed with armies,
- then know that the desolation thereof
- is nigh."

- Dan. 9:26 "And after sixty-two weeks shall
- Messiah be cut off, but not for
- himself: and the people of the prince
- that shall come shall destroy the city
- and the sanctuary; and the end
- thereof shall be with a flood, and
- unto the end of the war desolations
- are determined."

- Luke 21:21-22 "Then let them which are in
- Judaea flee to the mountains and let
- them that in the mist of it depart out;
- and let not them that are in the
- countries enter thereinto.
- vs22 For these be the days of vengeance,
- that all things which are written may
- be fulfilled."

Now for a few minutes let's consider:

- Daniel 9:23 and following
 - Gabriel comes to Daniel and says; "for
 - you are greatly beloved; therefore
 - understand the matter, and consider
 - the vision."

Like all apocalyptic language one must

- be careful not to stress the meaning
- especially numbers. With that said, let's
- consider what Gabriel says to Daniel.

- Gabriel gives a synopsis of what we have
- been studying.
- Dan. 9:24 "Seventy weeks are determined upon
- your people and upon your holy city,
- to finish the transgression, and to
- make an end of sins, and to make
- reconciliation for iniquity, and to
- bring in everlasting righteousness,
- and to seal up the vision and prophecy
- and to anoint the most Holy."

vs25 "Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times." (Side bar): Neh. 2:17-19 "Then said Nehemiah unto them, See you the distress that we are in, how Jerusalem, lies in waste, and the gates thereof are burned with

fire: come let us build up the wall of Jerusalem, that we be no more a reproach. vs18 Then I told them of the hand of my God, which was good upon me; And they said, Let us rise up and build. So they strengthened their hands for this good work. vs19 ...(And those nations around heard it) They laughed us to scorn, and despised us, and said, What is this thing you do? Will you rebel against the king?

Neh. 4:6 "So built we the wall; and all the wall was joined together unto the half thereof; for the people had a mind to work." vs14 "And I looked, and rose up, and said unto the nobles, and to the rulers, and to the rest of the people, Be not you afraid of them remember the Lord,..." Now back to Daniel 9

- ..the streets and wall will be rebuilt..
- Dan. 9:26 "And after threescore and two
- weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but
- not for himself: and the people of the
- Prince that shall come shall destroy
- the city and the sanctuary; and the
- end thereof shall be with a flood, and
- unto the end of the war desolations
- are determined."

Dan. 9:27 "And He shall confirm the covenant with many for one week; and in the midst of the week He shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overflowing of abominations He shall make it desolate even until the consummation, and that

desolate."

determined shall be poured upon the

Dan. 7:13 "I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before Him. Vs14 And there was given unto to him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, all people, nations, and languages, should serve him; his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which never be destroyed."

- Matt. 28:18 "And Jesus came and spoke to
- them, saying, All power is given unto
- me in heaven and in earth. vs19
- Go you therefore, and teach all nations
- baptizing them in the name of the
- Father, and of the Son, and of the
- Holy Spirit:" Acts 1:9b "...while they
- beheld, He was taken up, and a cloud
- received Him out of their sight."

- The temple being destroyed is recorded
- in Matthew, Mark, and Luke.

- Now let's look at what Mark has to say.
 - Mark13:9-10 "But take heed to yourselves;
 - for they shall deliver you up to
 - councils; and in the synagogues you
 - shall be beaten; and you shall be
 - brought before rulers and kings for
 - my sake, for a testimony against them.

- Mk. 13:10 "And the gospel must first be
- published among all nations."
- vs13 "And you shall be hated of all men
- for my name's sake; but he that shall
- endure unto the end, the same shall
- be saved."
- vs14 "But when you shall see the abomi-
- nations of desolation, spoken by
- Daniel the prophet...."

- Mk. 13:15 "And let him that is on the housetop
 not go down....
- vs16 "And let him in that is in the field not
 turn back to take his garment
- vs17 "But woe to them that are with child
- vs19 "For in those days shall be affliction,
- such as was not from the beginning
- of the creation which God created unto
- this time, neither shall be." маtt. 24: 21-22

Matt. 24:30,33-34 "Then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory."vs31 And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other."

- Matt. 24:33 "So likewise you, when you shall
- see all these things, know that it is
- near, even at the door."
- vs34 "Verily I say unto you, <u>This</u>
- <u>generation</u> shall not pass, till all
- these things be fulfilled."

- century needed to take heed of the
- prophecy of Daniel and Isaiah those of us
- living today better learn from what is
- written concerning the:

Final Judgement of God

Lk. 2:8-11 "And there were in the country shepherds....vs9 And lo, the angel of the Lord came unto them,....vs10 And the angel said "Fear not: for, behold I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. vs11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David, a Savior, which is Christ the Lord.

Jn.12:47 "And if any man hear my words, and believes not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world. vs48 He that rejects me, and receives not my words, hath one that judges him; the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day."

- Rm. 6:17-18 "But God be thanked, that you
- were the servants of sin, but you have
- obeyed from the heart that form of
- doctrine which was delivered you.
- vs 18 Being then made free from sin,
- you became the servants of
- righteousness."

- Jn. 14:6 "Jesus said unto them, I am the way,
- the truth, and the life: no man comes
- to the Father, but by me.
- Jn.8:24b "...for if you believe not that I am
- He, you shall die in your sins."
- Mk.16:16 "He that believes and is baptized
- shall be saved; but he that believes
- not shall be damned."

Heb.12:25-29 "See that you refuse not him that speaks. For if they escaped not who refused him that spoke on earth, much more shall not we escape if we turn away from him that speaks from heaven: vs26 Whose voice then shook the earth; but now he hath Promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven.

"And this word, Yet once more, Heb. 12:27 signify the removing of those things that are shaken, as of things that are made, that those things which can not be shaken may remain.vs28 Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. vs29 For our *God is a consuming* fire."

- Matt.10:14-15 "And whosoever shall not
- receive you, nor hear your words,
- when you depart out of that house or
- city, shake off the dust of your feet."
- vs15 Verily I say unto you, It shall be more
- tolerable for the land of Sodom and
- Gomorrah in the <u>day of judgement</u>,
- than for that city."

2 Pet. 3:2 "That you may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Savior: vs3 Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days, scoffers, walking after their own lust, vs4 And saying, Where is the promise of His coming? vs5 For this they are willingly ignorant of,..."

- 2 Pet. 3:9-10 "The Lord is not slack concerning
 His promise,.... vs10 But the DAY of
 the Lord will come as a thief in the
 night; in the which the heavens shall
 pass away with a great noise, and the
 elements shall melt with fervent heat,
- the earth also and the works that are
- therein shall be burned up."

- 2 Pet. 3:12 "Looking for and hasting unto the
- coming of the "day of God", wherein
- the heavens being on fire shall be
- dissolved, and the elements shall melt
- with fervent heat?

- 2 Thess. 1:7-8 "And to you who are troubled
- rest with us, when the Lord Jesus
- shall be revealed from heaven with
- His mighty angels, vs8 In flaming fire
- taking vengeance on them that know
- not God, and that obey not the gospel
- of our Lord Jesus Christ."

- Matt. 24:13 "But he that shall endure unto the
- end, the same shall be saved."
