The different terms used to describe an elder:

- Elder/ presbyter
 - Greek term: presbuteros (pres-boo'ter-os)
 - It is defined as: "older"
- Bishop/Overseer
 - Greek term: episkopos (ep-is'-kop-os)
 - It is defined as: "a superintendent"
- Shepherd/Pastor
 - Greek term: poimaino (poy-mah'-eeno) from the term poimen (poymane')
 - It is defined as: "to tend as a shepherd of"

- Defining Deacon:
 - Greek term: diakonos (dee-ak'-on-os)
 - It is defined as: "an attendant"
 - It is from a word that means "to run errands"
 - Simply this term refers to a servant.
