Ahab Reigns in Israel

(875 BC – 854 BC)

An overview of Ahab's life:

- 1 Kings 16:29 (ESV) (29 *In the thirty-eighth year of Asa king of Judah, Ahab the son of Omri began to reign over Israel, and Ahab the son of Omri reigned over Israel in Samaria twenty-two years.*)
- 1 Kings 16:30 (ESV) (30 *And Ahab the son of Omri did evil in the sight of the LORD, more than all who were before him.*)
- 1 Kings 16:31 (ESV) (31 *And as if it had been a light thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, he took for his wife Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal king of the Sidonians, and went and served Baal and worshiped him.*)
 - Exodus 34:12 – 16
 - Deuteronomy 7:3 – 6
