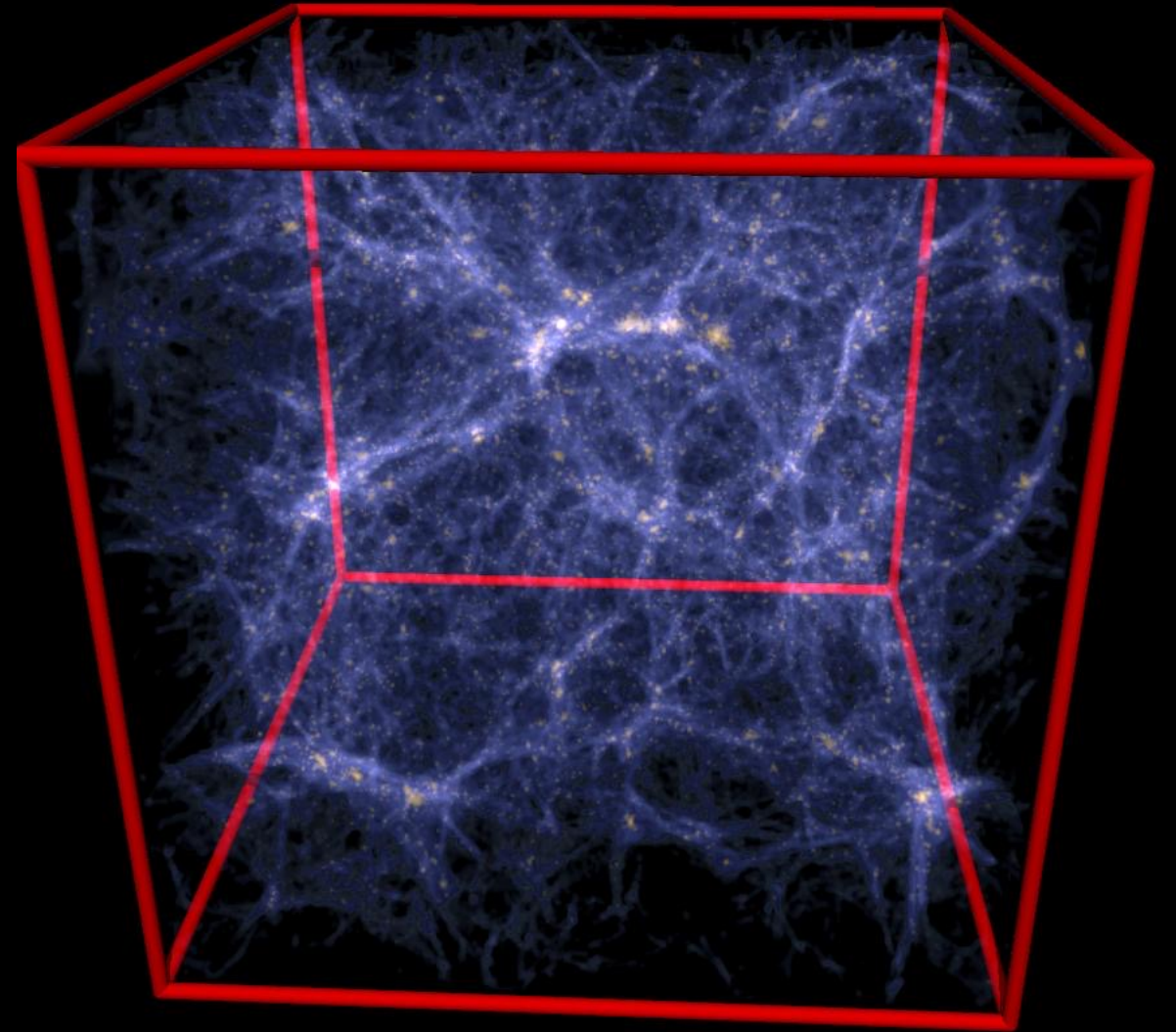

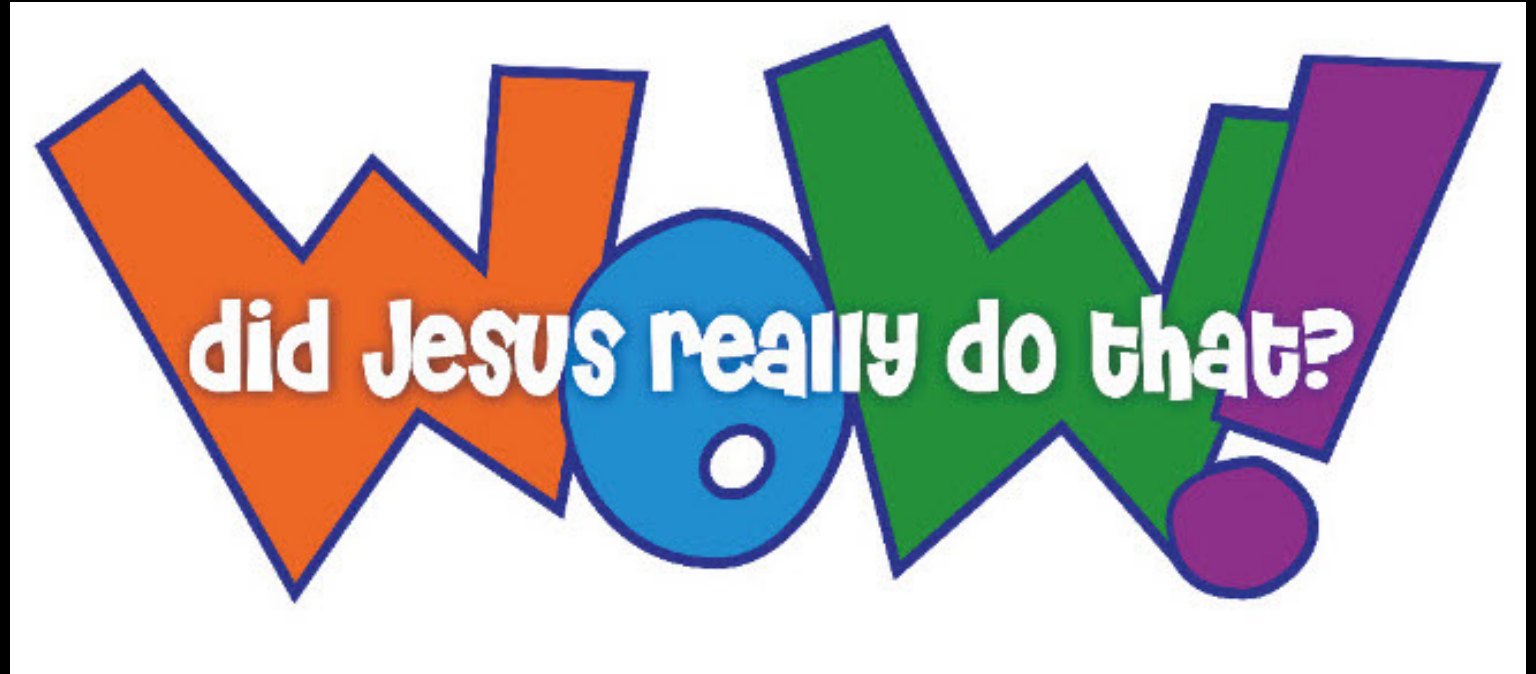

Defining the terms for Satan:


- Satan
 - Satanus (sat-an-as')
 - It is defined as “the accuser.”
- Devil
 - Diabolos (dee-ab'-ol-os)
 - It is defined as “false accuser, devil, slanderer.”
- We must remember Satan is not God!
- We must realize that Satan does not have the powers of God.

Satan does not have all knowledge, God knows all!




Satan is not all powerful, God holds all-power!
