

What are the doctrines of Dispensationalism?

A Brief History of the Dispensational doctrines:

- It did not exist before the 19th century.
- In 1820 or so there was a revival in Glasgow, Scotland where a young teenage girl named McDonald claimed to have a vision of a pre-tribulation rapture of the church out of this world and into Heaven. At this revival, there was a man named Darby (one of the founders of the Plymouth Brethren denomination) who took this doctrine to the United States.
- In America Mr. Darby came in contact with a man named Dwight L. Moody (founder of the Moody Bible Institute and Moody Press), who was a famous preacher of the day.
 Following their meeting, Moody became a worldwide disseminator of the doctrine of Dispensationalism and a Pre-Tribulation Rapture.
- Out of this came novels based on the Dispensational doctrine. One such novel was "Jesus is coming."





A Brief History of the Dispensational doctrines:

- The Scofield Reference Bible was first published in 1909.
- C.I. Scofield was the first to add headings to the bible, not just chain references in the margins. Being a believer of the Dispensational doctrines, he added headings like "Jesus predicts the Rapture" in Matthew 24.
- From there, the doctrine of Dispensationalism made its way into the mainstream of denominational churches.


What is the doctrine of the "Rapture"?


- It can be a complicated discussion due the many variant versions of the doctrine.

There two types of Dispensational doctrines:






