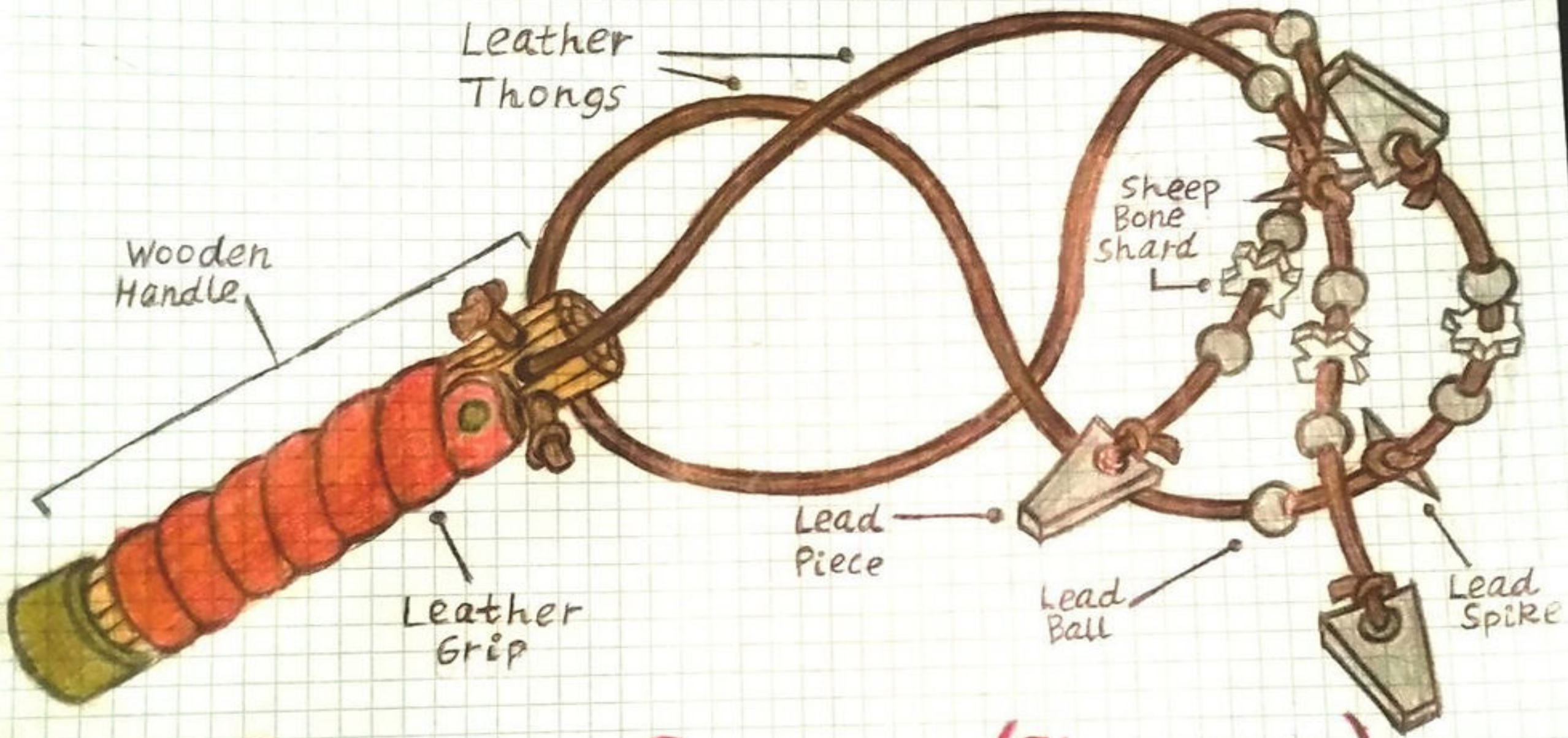
# Biblical Timeline of the Jesus' Resurrection

- Friday (Jewish Time: Friday AM):
