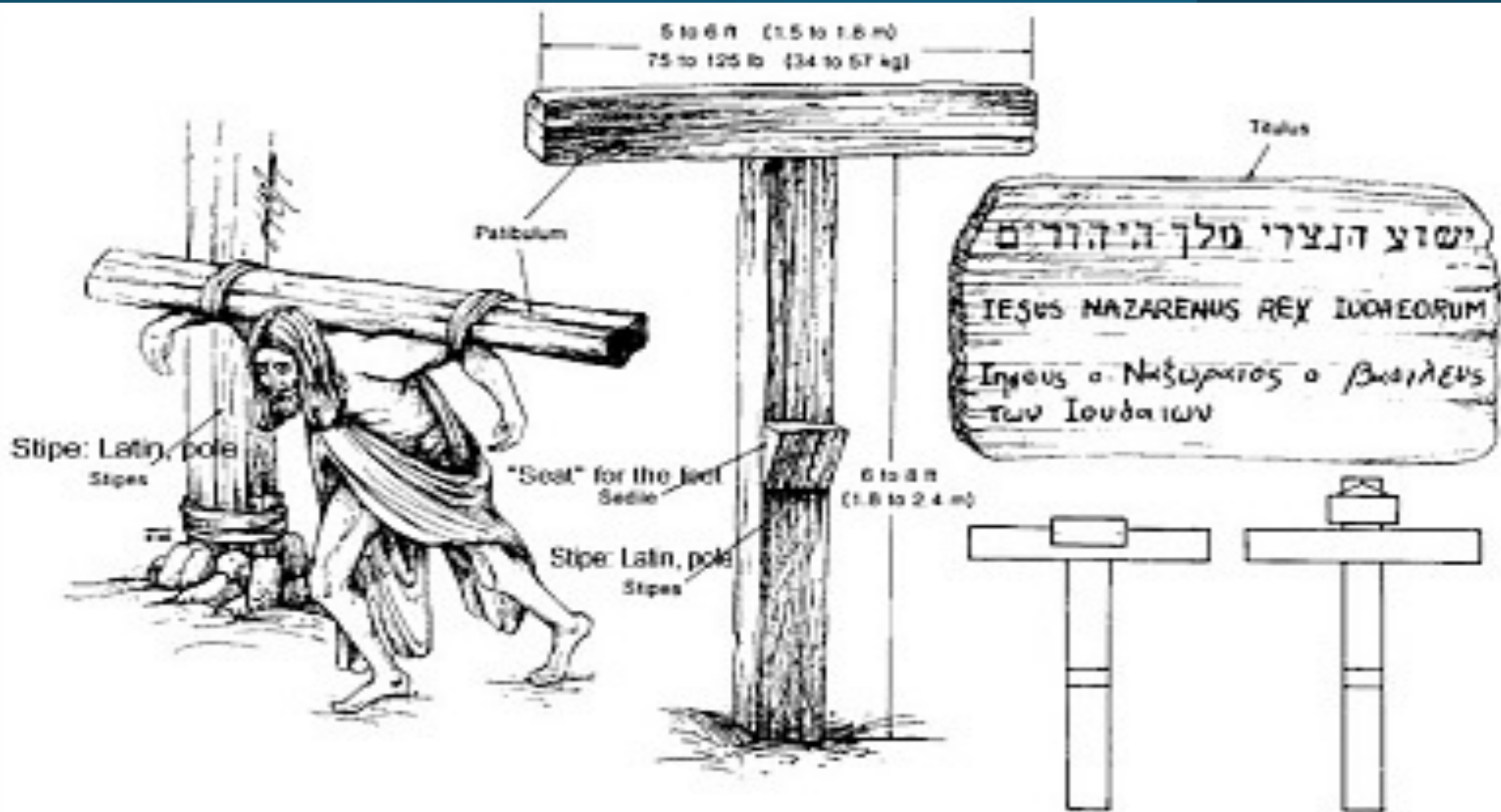


Biblical Timeline of the Jesus' Resurrection

- Friday (Jewish Time: Friday Daytime):
 - Jesus is taken before the full Sanhedrin. (Matthew 27:1 – 2; Mark 15:1; Luke 22:66 – 71)
 - Jesus is before Pilate for the first time. (Matthew 27:2 – 14; Mark 15:2 – 5; Luke 23:1 – 5; John 18:28 – 32)
 - Judas hangs himself. (Matthew 27:3 – 10; Acts 1:15 – 19)
 - Jesus is sent to be tried before Herod. (Luke 23:6 – 12)
 - Jesus is returned to Pilate for a second time. (Matthew 27:15 – 26; Mark 15:6 – 15; Luke 23:13 – 25; John 18:28 – 19:16)
 - Pilate offers the Israelites a choice: Jesus or Barabbas.
 - Jesus is sent to be scourged.
 - The People call for Jesus to be crucified.
 - Pilate washes his hands.
