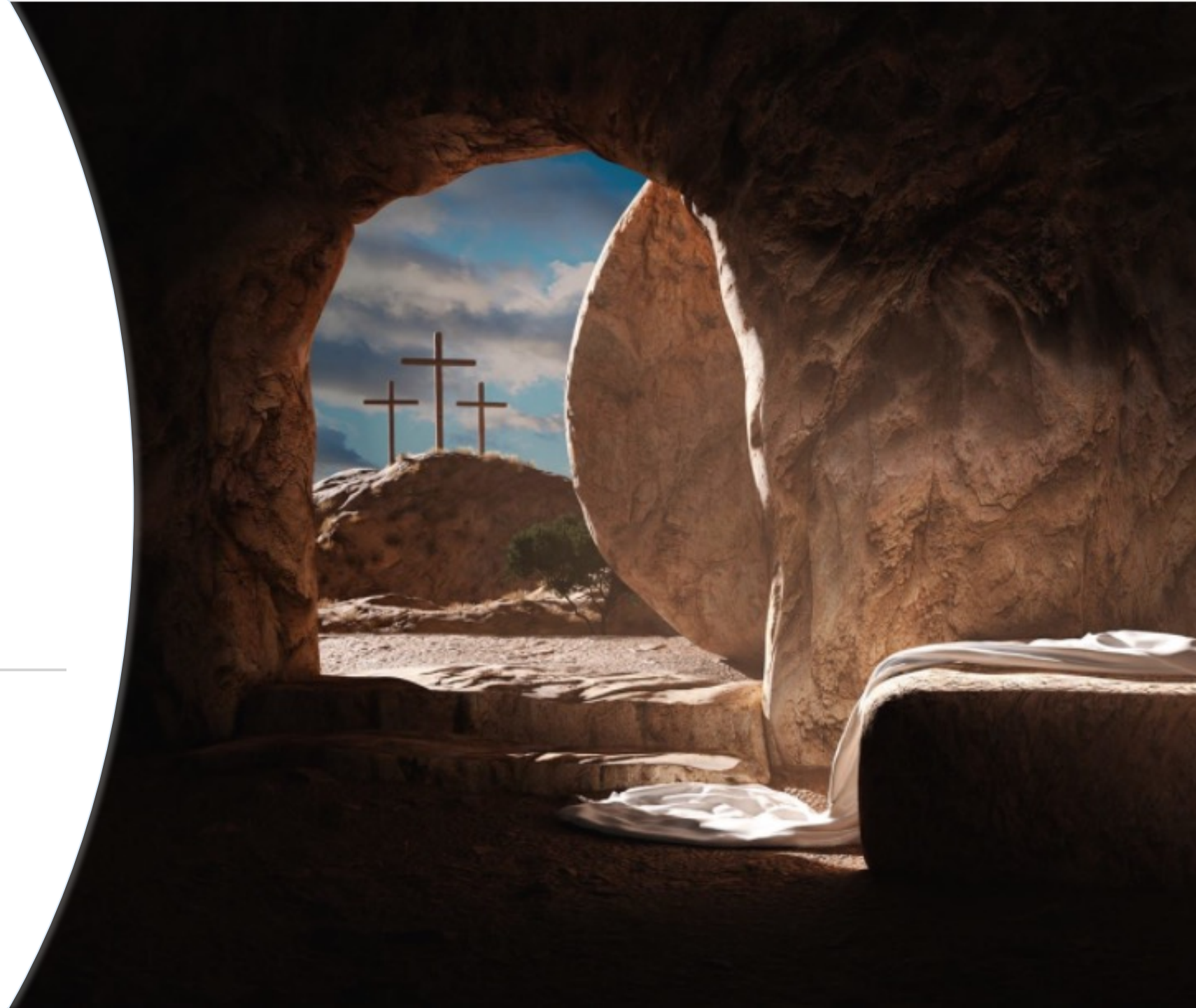




Biblical Timeline of Jesus' Resurrection

- Saturday (Jewish Time: Evening & Morning):
 - The Pharisees set a seal on Jesus' tomb because they knew of His teaching on His resurrection. (Matthew 12:40, Matthew 16:21, Matthew 17:22 – 23, Matthew 20:17 – 19)
 - Jesus' spirit rests in Hades (Paradise).
