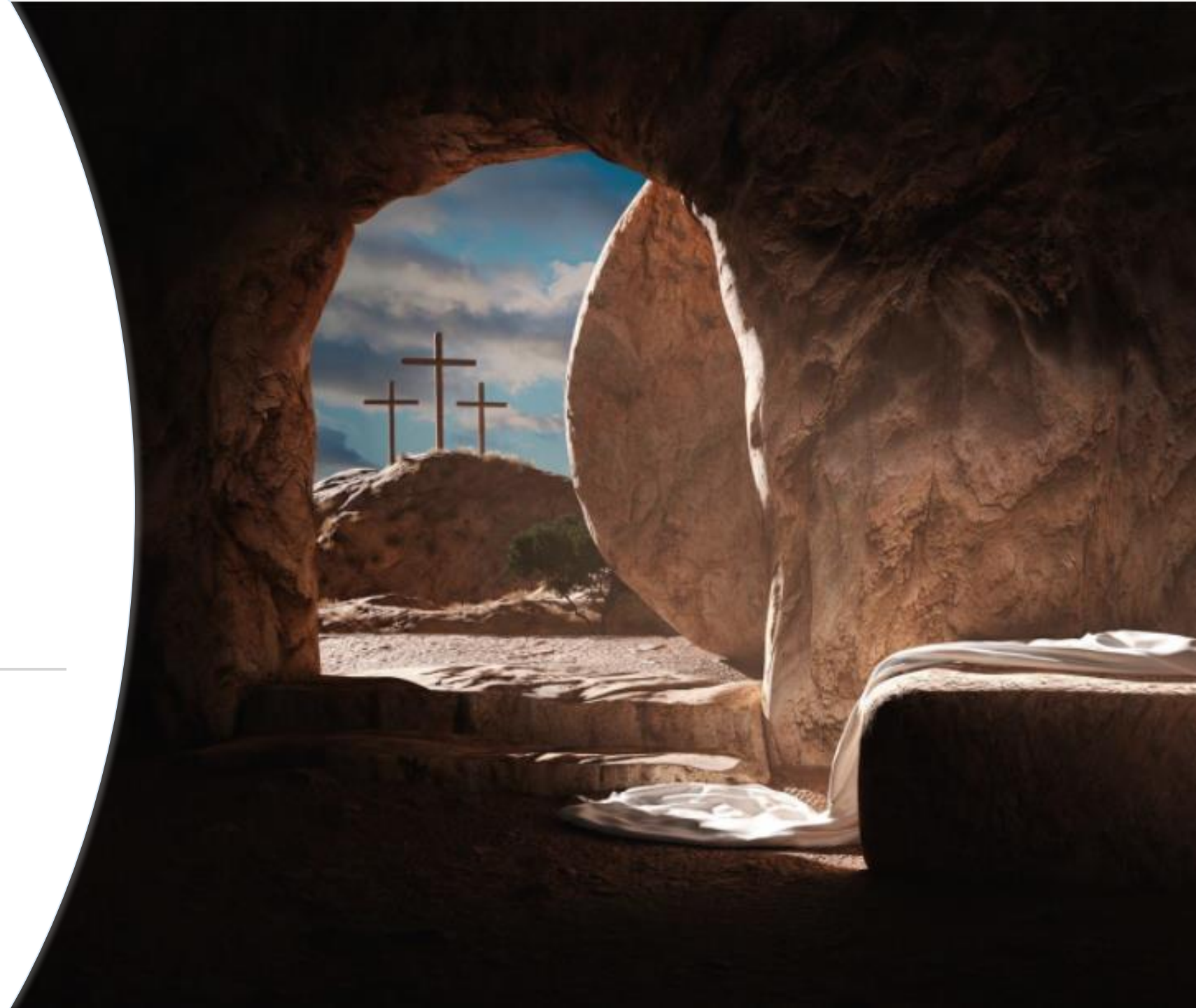

# Biblical Timeline of Jesus' Resurrection

- Sunday (Jewish Time: Sunday):
  - The Tomb is discovered to be empty! (Matthew 28:1 – 10, Mark 16:1 – 8, Luke 24:1 – 12, John 20:1 – 10)

# Review of the events surrounding the empty Tomb:

Matthew 28:1 – 10, Mark 16:1 – 8, Luke 24:1 – 12, John 20:1 – 10

Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary (the mother of James & Joses), Salome, and other women come to the tomb early on Sunday (the first day of the week) morning and find the stone rolled away and the tomb.

Two angels tell the women that Jesus has risen and that they are to tell the disciples to go to Galilee and Jesus will meet them there.

Mary Magdalene runs first to tell the disciples of what has happened while the other women stay at the tomb.

When Peter and John hear that the tomb is empty, they run to the tomb with Mary Magdalene following them. Peter goes into the tomb first and then John to see that it is indeed empty.

The Sanhedrin devises a lie about the empty tomb. (Matthew 28:11 – 15)

# Biblical Timeline of Jesus' Resurrection

- Sunday and the following days and weeks:
  - Jesus appears to the his followers. (Matthew 28:16 – 20, Mark 16:9 – 14, Luke 24:13 – 49, John 20:11 – 29, John 21:1 – 24, 1 Corinthians 15:1 – 8)

# The order of His appearances:
