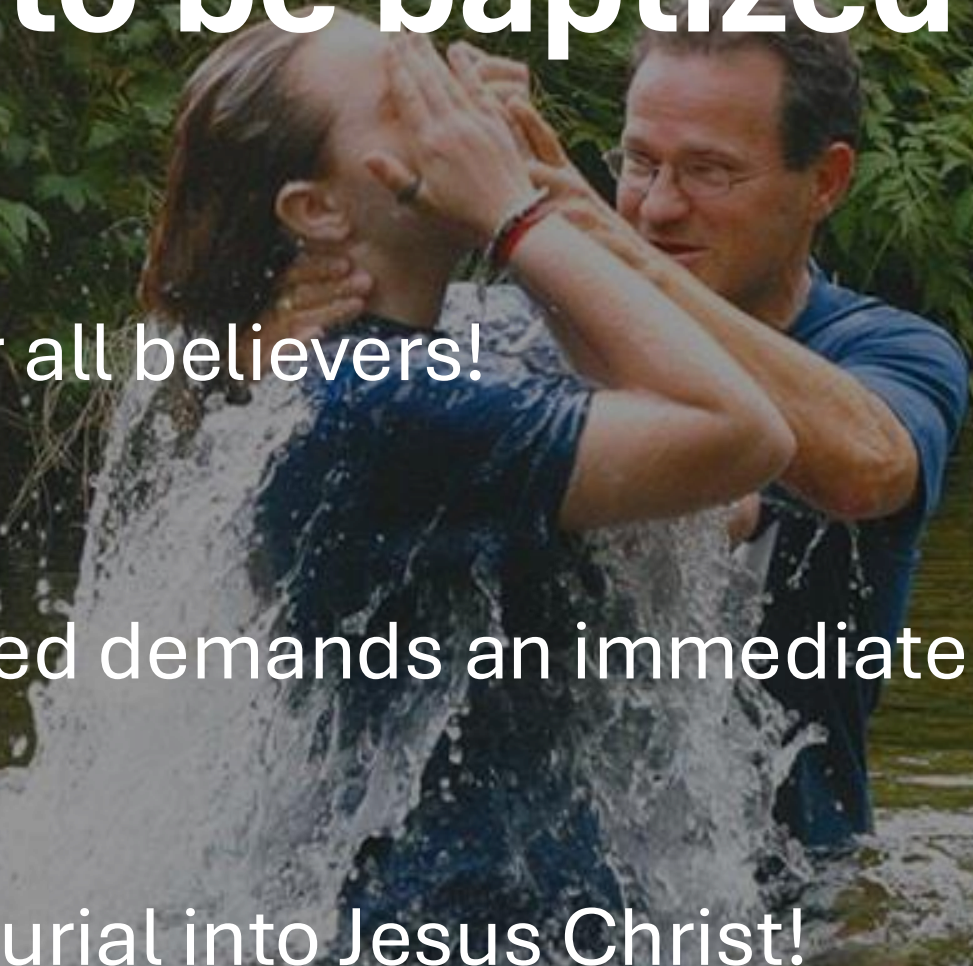

TRAINING THE SAVED TO REACH THE LOST

How does the Word of God define the proper way to be baptized (immersed)?

- Baptism is commanded for all believers!
 - Acts 19:1 – 5
 - Mark 16:15 – 16
- The command to be baptized demands an immediate response!
 - Acts 8:35 – 39
- Baptism is an immersion/burial into Jesus Christ!
